What is a Change of Program?

Change of program is changing your major for example, changing your major from (Business to a major in Arts and Sciences) or starting a new degree level (Business to Masters) is considered a change of program.

Change of Program Instructions:

F-1 students who plan on changing their program or level of study must obtain a new Form I-20 to reflect that change.

What do I need to do in order to change a major?

Discuss the change with your Immigration Advisor.

- Submit an official letter of acceptance to the new major/ program from your current academic advisor to OIA.
- Copy of your current I-94 (<u>https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/I94)</u>

If change of major extend beyond your current length of your study in the U.S. that is currently noted on your I-20? Please submit the following documents to OIA.

• Submit Original Financial statement to OIA :(Document must show One year of expenses or if less time is needed, equal to the length of the time needed to finish the program)
