Texas Success Initiative Exam

What is TSI?

The Texas Success Initiative (TSI) is a program designed to help ensure that all students enrolled in a Texas public institution of higher education are going to be academically successful. The TSI will determine readiness for college-level course work in the areas of reading, writing, and mathematics. Incoming students that are not exempt are required to take the TSI Assessment to determine their readiness for college-level courses and success in those courses. TSI exemptions can be made based on previous college course work and/or test scores.

Where can you take the exam?

Option 1:

Option 2:

If you are out of the United States, you have the option to take the exam online. Please follow the instructions below:

STEP 1: Complete the Pre-Assessment Activity, available online through the Testing Center's website.

STEP 2: Register for the TSI exam: www2.registerblast.com/tamusa/exam/list

- a) Select TSI as the Group
- b) Select Remote TSI Testing
- c) Select TSI at home virtual proctor
- d) Continue and compete through registration.

STEP 4: Verify receipt and print the email for your Remote TSI Assessment
