Summary

- 1. URC Budget update FY2019
 - Lloyd Butler presented a budget update for fiscal year 2019. The update began with a review of FY 2018 revenue and expenditures budget to actuals analysis. Noted in the analysis was \$14M of unspent revenue funds. Divisions were allowed to carry forward to FY 2019 unspent operating expense budget funds.
 - b. FY 2019 has slower than anticipated enrollment growth. However, enrollment for FY 2019 is higher than the previous year by 3%. Enrollment growth is expected to increase again next year in response to reorganization in the Enrollment Management division and utilization of customer relationship management (CRM) technologies.
 - c. The Revised FY19 Revenue Budget is based on the 20th class day certification. Budget for FY19 will be revised downward to correspond to the 20th class day certification.
 - d. Divisions and departments were asked to provide feedback for revising FY 2019 budgets. The revised FY19 URC budget incorporated the feedback provided by departments to the vice presidents. The key take-away is that the University is fairly nimble in adjusting to reflect changes in enrollment and budget.
 - e. Announcements: Lloyd will provide an update on reserves at the nest URC meeting. The Legislative Appropriation Request, prepared by Denis and Sharon, is due October 17th.
