



**EMPLOYABILITY.** Graduates of the ABA program will be qualified to fill the ever-increasing demand for Board Certified Behavior Analysts and Assistant Behavior Analysts at ABA companies and school systems. The Behavior Analyst Certification Board (BACB) in 2019 reported that demand for Behavior Analysts has increased each year since 2010; specifically, from 2010 to 2018, there was a 942 percent increase, and from 2017 to 2018 there was a 127 percent increase. While the demand for Behavior Analysts exists across the nation, Texas has the third-highest demand (BACB, 2019). In San Antonio, there are 17 school districts and over 30 ABA companies. In 2014, the BACB reported that more than half of Behavior Analysts made at least \$65,000 annually.
