

IACUC SOP:	SOP Animal Identification Cards

Purpose:

This SOP concerns animal identification.

- Animal Identification Cards are used to identify animals/enclosures within the facility to meet regulatory requirements, provide a method for investigators to differentiate between animals/enclosures.
- 2. Animal Identification Cards identify group housed animals at the cage level, not individual animals within a group. This card may also be used to identify singly housed animals.
- 3. All animals within the facilities must have an Animal Identification Card attached to the enclosure.
- 4. If an enclosure does not have an Animal Identification Card, notify the PI. Ensure the enclosure is properly identified, and an identification card produced and placed on the enclosure.
- 5. If an enclosure is empty but contains bedding or other items but no animals, it must have a card indicating such.
- 6. Each Animal Identification Card must contain the following:

- Scientific Name
- Name of PI
- Emergency Contact Number
- Special considerations
- Date of arrival
- Sex of animals
- Number of animals
- Vendor Name
