

# Digication e-Portfolio FAQ

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## GENERAL QUESTIONS

- Q. What is Digication?**
- A. Digication is an e-Portfolio program that allows you to design and share a collection of work.
- Q. How do I access Digication?**
- A. You can access Digication through a Blackboard course, through JagWire, or through our instance of Digication at [tamusa.digication.com](http://tamusa.digication.com)
- Q. What is an e-Portfolio?**
- A. An e-Portfolio is an online collection of your work. It could be for a class, department, or just for your reference.
- Q. What can I share in my e-Portfolio?**
- A. Digication allows for the sharing of papers, photos, videos, online materials, and select social media feeds.
- Q. Who can see my e-Portfolio?**
- A. You can change the security settings on your e-Portfolios to reflect their purpose. For example, you could set a course e-Portfolio to view only for those in a course.

**Q. What should I NOT post in an e-Portfolio?**

A. You should avoid posting any copyrighted materials in your e-Portfolio. Also, you should avoid posting any obscene or objectionable materials. Remember, Digication and A&M – San Antonio both have User Agreements that you are agreeing to by using our systems.

**Q. Can I create an e-Portfolio on my own without a course in BlackBoard?**

A. Yes. You can create your own e-Portfolios by accessing our instance of Digication through JagWire, or at [tamusa.digication.com](http://tamusa.digication.com)

**Q. Can I change my username in Digication?**

A. No. Because Digication links to various campus systems, you cannot change your username.

**Q. Can I change my password in Digication?**

A. Yes. You can change your password for Digication if you wish.

**Q. Can I make my e-Portfolio public to anyone on the internet?**

A. Yes. You can adjust your security settings on any e-Portfolio so you can share with anyone if you wish.

**Q. How do I make an e-Portfolio?**

A. Directions on the process can be found on our instance of Digication [here](#), or on the ITS Website [here](#). Digication makes the process simple by using templates, themes, and an easy to use interface.

**Q. What is a template? What is a theme? How are they different?**

A. A template is the framework of an e-Portfolio and includes its sections and pre-built modules. Specific templates could be used by an instructor or program. A theme, on the other hand, is the aesthetic look of the e-Portfolio – the colors, fonts, banner, etc.

**Q. After choosing a theme, can I change it later on?**

A. Yes. You can always alter your e-Portfolio's colors, backgrounds, etc.

**Q. What are modules?**

A. Modules provide areas for you to add images, movies, text and links to websites or files within your pages. More than one module can be added to a page to allow you to customize the display of your content.

Click on the button 'Add A Module' to add a module to your page.

**Q. How do you add a Module?**

- A. Click on 'Add This Module'. Click on 'Done' to start adding content (or select more modules to add). Upon clicking 'Done', the following options will become available:
- 'Add A Module' allows additional modules to be added to this page.
  - 'Publish All' allows you to publish any saved media or text to your e-Portfolio. This is especially helpful when there is more than one module on a page.
  - The tab 'View (Media or Text)' is a view of your saved, but not published, module content (drafts).
  - The tab 'Edit' lets you add and edit module content.
  - The tab 'Publish' lets you publish a specific module of your e-Portfolio.
  - The tab 'Delete' allows you to delete the module from the page.
  - 'Drag to reorder' allow you to reorder modules on a page.

**Q. What are tags and why should I use them?**

A. Tags are keywords or terms assigned to an e-Portfolio to help describe it and allow it to be found by browsing or searching using that term. A tag can serve as a quick identifier. For instance, if your e-Portfolio is tagged with the keyword 'capstone,' it will be easier to find if someone searches for that particular term. An e-Portfolio will not be searchable if it's set to private.

**Q. I have added Modules and work to my e-Portfolio, but people cannot see it. Why not?**

A. Make sure you have published each Module by clicking the 'Publish' tab. Usually Modules are not viewable because they have not been published. Digication produces a red text box on Modules that have changed and not been published.

## STUDENT SPECIFIC QUESTIONS

**Q. Why should I use Digication?**

A. E-Portfolios are a great reflection of your growth as a student. Digication makes keeping your products of learning together simple, and user friendly.

**Q. How long do I have access to my e-Portfolios in Digication?**

A. Digication will save your e-Portfolios for as long as you need. For example, if you graduate and wish to continue using your Digication e-Portfolios, you can arrange for this use with Digication.

**Q. Can my e-Portfolio be graded by an instructor?**

A. Yes. Instructors can grade an e-Portfolio as part of your course work.

**Q. Can I work on my e-Portfolio from home?**

A. Yes. As long as you have internet access you can log into JagWire and access your e-Portfolios.

**Q. Can I create an e-Portfolio for personal use?**

A. Yes. You can create an e-Portfolio for personal use, but remember that you are operating under Digication's and A&M – San Antonio's User Agreements. Please refrain from posting copyrighted materials, or anything that could be considered obscene or objectionable.

## **INSTRUCTOR SPECIFIC QUESTIONS**

**Q. Why should I use Digication?**

A. E-Portfolios are a great way to collect student work over the period of a course. It collects all work in one easy place that can be accessed by all in a course. You can also create your own e-Portfolios to house examples of your work or resume items.

**Q. Can an e-Portfolio be graded by an instructor?**

A. Yes. Instructors can grade an e-Portfolio as part of course work.

**Q. Why should I create a template for my students?**

A. To make it easy for you to find materials in your students' e-Portfolios. If you're reading twenty different e-Portfolios that each contain a large number of assignments, you can make it easier for yourself by having them all structured the same way.

**Q. If I change the template e-Portfolio after my students have created e-Portfolios from it, will their e-Portfolios change to reflect the new template?**

A. No. Creating an e-Portfolio from a template is a one-time process, so make sure you get your template in a form you're happy with before you ask the students to make their e-Portfolios.

**Q. Once I create a template e-Portfolio, can it be used for other courses?**

A. Yes. Digication houses all your created e-Portfolios, and you can access them through each Blackboard course you enable Digication in.
