Legacy Transfer Exemption Waiver

- DD 214 of Veteran (Service 2 or Member 4- Honorable or General Discharge)
- Ch.33 Post 9/11 Gi Bill Certificate of Eligibility (Not Required if Veteran Discharged Before 9/11/01)
- Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificate, Adoption Documentation, or
Recent IRS Tax Transcript Proving Dependency of Child (Needed annually)
- Death Certificate for Deceased Veteran
- Hazlewood Hours for Student **and** Veteran (<https://www.tvc.texas.gov/education/hazlewood/>)

Hazlewood Exemption Waiver Spouse or Child (Non-Legacy)

- Hazlewood Application
- DD 214 of Veteran (Service 2 or Member 4- Honorable or General Discharge)
- VA Rating Decision Letter Indicating the Veteran is 100% Permanently and Totally Disabled or
DD 1300 Report of Casualty
- Ch.33 Post 9/11 Gi Bill Certificate of Eligibility (Not Required if Veteran Discharged Before 9/11/01)*
 - Ch.35 Certificate of Eligibility (Dependents Education Act) sufficient. If applicable
- Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificate, Adoption Documentation, or
Recent IRS Tax Transcript Proving Dependency of Child (Needed annually)
