Suggestion Box Items as of September 2022

1. Early Release (Anonymous 9/1/22): Will there be an early release on Friday for the Labor Day weekend?
 - a. Response from HR 9/1/22: We have not heard from the Chancellor's office re early release tomorrow. This may be due to not all System members taking Labor Day as a holiday. Looks like he usually grants early release on the day preceding a mandated System holiday.

We are aware that Lot 2 is an extremely popular lot and we are assessing those peak times to ramp up parking enforcement so that we are encouraging everyone to park in the lot in which they have a permit. We are also in the process of hiring more parking enforcers. In the event that a Lot 2 permit holder cannot locate parking in Lot 2, they can park in the Lot 2 overflow located in Lot 3.
